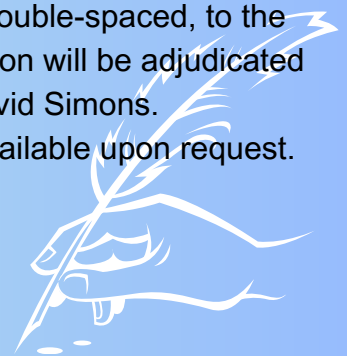
XABIA BOOK CIRCLE LAUNCHES 2024 SHORT STORY COMPETITION
