Research project on the retired British population of Alicante Province

real pleasure to listen to your stories and reflections.

As you already know, my doctoral research focuses on how retired British citizens experience life in Spain in the post-Brexit context, especially in relation to their transnational ties and sense of belonging.

At this stage, I am now transcribing and beginning to analyse the interviews. The aim is to identify common themes and patterns that help explain how retirement migration is evolving under new political and social conditions. I will be continuing my fieldwork over the summer and autumn in other parts of the province, and I am looking forward to returning to these conversations later in the writing process.

In this regard, I will be sure to let you know of any partial publications I make on the subject, as well as to inform you when I deposit and defend my thesis (expected in November 2027). If you're interested in the broader context of this study, you may enjoy a recently published article I co-authored with my PhD supervisors, Professor Raquel Huete and Professor Alejandro Mantecón, and other researchers in this field.

The article looks at the impact of Brexit on older British migrants in Spain, including changes in residency, mobility, and familistic wellbeing. https://reis.cis.es/index.php/reis/article/view/2342

Please be aware that there is a group of people going door-to-door posing as Internal Affairs employees. They have documents and letterheads from the Ministry of Interior, Justice, and Peace, claiming they need to verify that everyone has valid ID for the upcoming census.

They are everywhere and look smart.

Someone will come to your house and say,
"I want to take your photo/fingerprint according to some scheme."

They have a laptop, a biometric machine, and a list of all the names.

They show the menu and ask for all this information.

Please be aware that no such initiative exists on the part of the government.



Please know that all of this is false.

NOLOTIL



A REMINDER NOT TO TAKE THIS DRUG EVEN IF PRESCRIBED

Press coverage of tragic deaths associated to the drug Nolotil/Metamizole really concerns all of us.

If you are in the unfortunate situation where you require strong painkillers, whether prescribed by your local doctor, clinic or hospital, you need to know this. Please be aware and make sure you are not prescribed either of these widely used drugs. They can have serious side effects, which seem to manifest themselves amongst Anglo Saxons/Northern Europeans including us Brits.

Over the last few years a Spanish medical translator has been fiercely campaigning to have the drug banned in Spain as it is in the UK, USA and many more countries. The tragic case histories make frightening reading: horrific side effects, organ failure, loss of white blood cells, sepsis, gangrene, amputations and permanent disability are documented side effects of Nolotil associated with these victims and a number of tragic deaths, all of which could have and should have been avoided.

Denia Hospital issued several years ago ADVICE against NOLOTIL being prescribed for Anglo Saxons. Only advising, not prohibiting, and with the pressure of work and staff turnover this advice may not always be heeded.

We know of one of our own Members, fortunately aware of Nolotil's deadly reputation, who had refused it in the hospital but then picked it up on her discharge post op painkiller prescription. FOR YOUR SAKE Make sure you are aware of what you are being administered or prescribed under medical care. Query it and avoid it.

It can also appear as METAMIZOLE, a post-op painkiller. This is NOLOTIL under another name. The medical governing body, whose job it is to decide whether there is a case to ban NOLOTIL, as has already happened in 40 other countries, are still reviewing evidence. In the meantime we all need to take responsibility too and make sure that we don't become part of that evidence.

We have recently purchased/sold bracelets to be worn stating we must not be given Nolotil or Metazimole which many members purchased. If you didn't get one we have invited the campaigner to be our guest speaker at the September General Assembly in Murla and she will bring some more which can be purchased.


